15 YEARS 64 Scholarships \$97,000 Alumni Donations

2008: Betty Kincaid Mathis, Mary Riley Martell, and their 1960 classmates introduced a \$500 scholarship. Betty Hart requested that the scholarships be made available to all SHS graduating seniors.

2012: The 1960 class decided to solicit donations from all SHS Alumni so that the scholarships could be increased. Fortunately, SHS annuals dating back to 1885 facilitated the creation of an alumni database which now includes more than 3,500 graduates. **Stanton Chapman**, class of 1965, maintains the database which can be accessed at sabinalisd.net. 2020-2022: Sabinal Alumni, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, was established in 2020 to solicit grants for scholarships. In 2021, scholarships were increased to \$2,000 per recipient, and with your support, we can increase to \$3,000 in 2022. The ultimate goal is to offer ten \$5,000 scholarships annually funded by donations from alumni, friends, family, and Texas foundations.
